A Call for Justice and Peace

In this statement, I want to express my opinions and feelings about the issues of violence and injustice that I and other women have faced. I also want to call for change and peace in our society. I hope you will listen to me and understand me.

Therefore, I demand that the authorities and the society take action and do something about this problem. I demand that they provide support, assistance, and protection to the victims of sexual violence and abuse according to their needs and preferences. I demand that they prevent, educate, and raise awareness about sexual violence and abuse among the public and the professionals.

Second, I want to talk about the problem of gender violence and discrimination. This is another serious and widespread problem that affects millions of women around the world. According to the United Nations, gender-based violence is "any act of gender-based violence that results in, or is likely to result in, physical, sexual or psychological harm or suffering to women, including threats of such acts, coercion or arbitrary deprivation of liberty, whether occurring in public or in private life".

Gender discrimination is "any distinction, exclusion or restriction made on the basis of sex which has the effect or purpose of impairing or nullifying the recognition, enjoyment or exercise by women [...] of human rights and fundamental freedoms in the political, economic, social, cultural, civil or any other field".

One of the causes of this problem is the patriarchal system and culture that dominates our society. This system and culture values men over women, gives men more power and privilege than women, and expects men and women to behave in certain ways according to their gender roles. This system and culture oppresses women and limits their freedom and potential.

I have experienced this problem myself. I have been discriminated against by men who thought they were better than me or had more rights than me because they were men. They did not respect me or treat me as an equal. They did not listen to me or value my opinions. They did not acknowledge my achievements or appreciate my contributions. They did not support me or encourage me.

I have also been subjected to violence by men who thought they had authority over me or could control me because they were men. They did not care about my feelings or needs. They did not respect my boundaries or choices. They did not honor my consent or dignity. They abused me physically, verbally, emotionally, financially, sexually.

This is not fair or right. This is not how it should be. This is not how a civilized and democratic society should treat its citizens, especially its women who are half of the population and the human race. This is not how a humane and compassionate society should treat its fellow human beings who are diverse and unique.

Therefore, I demand that the authorities and the society take action and do something about this problem. I demand that they eliminate gender-based violence and discrimination in all its forms and manifestations. I demand that they promote gender equality and empowerment in all spheres and levels of life. I demand that they respect, protect, and fulfill the human rights and fundamental freedoms of all women.

Third, I want to talk about the problem of violence and hatred in general. This is a global and universal problem that affects all people regardless of their gender, race, ethnicity, religion, nationality, or any other identity or characteristic. According to the World Health Organization, violence is "the intentional use of physical force or power, threatened or actual, against oneself, another person, or against a group or community, that either results in or has a high likelihood of resulting in injury, death,

psychological harm, maldevelopment or deprivation". Hatred is "a feeling of intense dislike or hostility towards someone or something".

One of the causes of this problem is the lack of love and peace in our hearts and minds.

I have experienced this problem myself. I have been hurt by people who did not love me or care about me. They did not show me kindness or compassion. They did not give me attention or affection. They did not make me happy or fulfilled. They left me lonely and empty.

I have also been harmed by people who did not want peace with me or for me. They did not respect me or cooperate with me. They did not understand me or accept me. They did not forgive me or apologize to me. They fought with me and against me.

This is not fair or right. This is not how it should be. This is not how a civilized and democratic society should treat its citizens, especially its fellow human beings who are living on the same planet and sharing the same resources. This is not how a humane and compassionate society should treat its fellow human beings who are feeling the same emotions and facing the same challenges.

Therefore, I demand that the authorities and the society take action and do something about this problem. I demand that they stop violence and hatred in all its forms and manifestations. I demand that they foster love and peace in all spheres and levels of life. I demand that they respect, protect, and fulfill the human dignity and well-being of all people.

In conclusion, I want to say that:

I am not a fool.

I am a strong woman.

Some might call me a bitch,
but I don't mind too much.

You have your games and your manipulations,
but I don't want to play them.

I know what I need, and

I won't settle for less than that.
I have had some time to think it over;
I gave you love, but you gave me lies.
Sweet little lies.
You were always in disguise.
You were what you consumed.

I've no cure for your confusion.

The First Book of Moses, Commonly Called Genesis

Gen. 1:1

Matthew 5:22

This is a polite way to say if your private parts are causing you offense, etc. cut them off....

Matthew 5:32

And if a woman divorce her husband? What then? If he beats her or otherwise breaks the contract first the contract no longer is, yes? Not addressed here.....

Matthew 5:39

Don't resist evil people, they only get violent. Also You only have to turn the "other cheek" ONCE. then its self defense. Of course, you can do it again. Self defense is not required.

Matthew 5:46

That doesn't mean hate those who love you and love those who hate you either.... Don't treat people who love you like its a crime! It is rewarding in an of itself to love people that love you. Why does the reward have to come from Heaven?

Matthew 5:47

OMG don't do anything we ever did.... lmao

Matthew 6:1-34

Yeah, stop doing this shit on TV? Mebbe? "for they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men." If I am uncomfortable rambling out prayers out loud in churches, where I am not even allowed to mention sexual abuse much less talk about this most heinous act against God and mankind, please don't persecute me in church! Damn!

Matthew 7:1

Judgment and discernment are two different but similar things. Its fine to recognize evil and respect the harm it can do.

Matthew 7:3-5

One of my favorite things He ever said. Men do this to women all the damn time

Matthew 7:6

Save the witty banter for people that deserve it. Don't enter a battle of wits with unarmed Chads

Matthew 7:9-10

Is it ok to dishonor parents like this? Asking for a "friend?"

Matthew 7:22-23

Aside from the obvious, it illustrates that God is not impressed with bragging.

Matthew 8:16

Demons are real according to these books. It says elsewhere not to fear them. Free will is sacred to God and angels all have free will. Fallen angels included. When God gives gifts, he doesn't rip them away, and fallen angels keep theirs -- thus demons have angelic gifts.

Matthew 8:26

To me this indicates that the Trickster aspect of the divine is there.... "Grumpy old man" energy. People blame the weather on God too much. God makes weather go away, but does not cause it *usually*

Matthew 9:30

There are allegations that because Jesus saw his death coming that it was "suicide" which annoys me. Clearly since He has said this more than once, He tried to avoid it.

Matthew 10:16

ANTI-VIOLENCE!

Matthew 10:19

You can still say what you want if you'd rather.... There is a reason there is no commandment against lying (especially white lies) I don't, personally, like being told what to say, and prefer suggestions to being told what to do

Matthew 10:25-35

DAPHNE Code "And be not afraid of them that kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell." This is about Lucy and the demons..... They cannot hurt your soul. Even if they "steal, buy, or threaten to destroy" it

Matthew 14:30

This is an interpretation of something that was a lie to begin with

Matthew 15:26

Don't cast pearls before pigs, I guess.

Matthew 16:6

I think this has a literal meaning as well, because all these extra chemicals in our food are not good

Matthew 16:18

He's saying it doesn't matter so much that Lucy wrote rubbish in this book. He is still gonna build his church atop of it.

Matthew 16:19

Yeah this is good to know

Matthew 16:23

Why do people think this is a metaphor or was said for the "benefit of an audience" when they take everything else literally? Seriously. Peter was the devil... Literally.

Maybe He said it like this, because gifted people often don't see what they see very clearly? I'm sure that He knew exactly what was going to happen, but wanted to express it in such a way that other people who have gifts could relate to?

Afterword

There is considerable material in the Bible that speaks out against violence, oppression and bloodshed. I hope I have proven that with my commentary and the passages I have chosen to comment on. I hope offering a more balanced perspective on what was seen, discovered and shared with the world has given a more balanced perspective on an important book of myths....

Mythology in general is very important. It is not exactly fiction. It is not exactly fact - especially not literally. But the Bible is, indeed, myths....

Yes, evil spirits are real. I have seen and heard enough evidence that proves it. Many hauntings are actually Lucy and the smurfs. Many “helpful” spirits that want to enter our bodies are not helpful at all. They may look and sound humanoid, but they are not friendly and do not have good intentions. Only evil spirits want to use bodies that do not belong to them. They may say and do things that confuse us about their intentions, but honestly, do not ever loan your body to any spirit. They do not have the right to bother you at all, no matter what you have done or said. God did not give them rights.... They just run amok. Like criminals. It doesn't matter if you do "things" to "invite" them or not. Inanimate objects are inanimate objects. Tarot cards are no more likely to have demons than your average handgun.

Sexual assault in particular is very confusing for its victims/survivors. It is, to put it bluntly, a big “mind fuck” for us. Especially when dogma tells us to turn the other cheek, not fight back, not resist evil people (does that include evil spirits? See what I mean?) It “exposes our nakedness” to anyone we interact with - especially for “rape exams.” Sometimes the sensations are “pleasurable” but the pleasure from rape is actually more like torture than pleasure.

Society has strict rules regarding how such things are reported and how victims are “supposed to act” On top of that, its socially unacceptable to see yourself as a “victim” and you’re supposed to regard yourself as a survivor. #MeToo

Also, satanic ritual abuse is a real thing. #GodHatesRape. God hates rape exams too. They are inherently misogynistic by nature. No victim is guilty of perjury, slander or oppression just because the crime is sexual assault especially without evidence.

So, to be helpful, I am listing why rape is the exception to the rules. Nobody has any business telling anyone else how to respond to attempted rape, **EVER**. Including Martin Luther King Jr, Ghandi, or even Jesus. It is also an exception to the rules because it never quite heals right. Never. Be gentle with each other.

- 1) Rape is good for nothing
- 2) Dead men don't rape
- 3) You don't have to follow the ten commandments with a rapist (i.e. you can kill a rapist)
- 4) It's no sin to lie to a rapist
- 5) Dead men and women don't molest children
- 6) Friendship is greater than love. Peace is friendship.
- 7) War is rape; war is NOT love
- 8) It's okay to hate rapists. Everyone hates people that rape their friends.
- 9) Rapists are NOT people, they do not get equal rights with people
- 10) Love is not punishment
- 11) Rape is the exception to the rule: love one another.
- 12) Rapists go to hell.
- 13) Killing rapists is not murder, it's pest control.
